

**PRESCHOOL PREP****EXCLUSION POLICY**

Control of communicable disease should be all parties' primary concern.

Policies and guidelines related to outbreaks of communicable diseases and illnesses in this facility have been developed with the help of the local health department and local pediatricians in order to protect the group including the health of your own child. I ask that parents assist me by keeping sick children at home. If they have or have experienced any of the following symptoms in the past 24 hours, they need to be kept at home and away from this facility.

- A fever of 100* orally or 99 under the arm.
- Signs of a newly developed cough or a severe cough.
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or an upset stomach.
- Unusual or unexplained loss of appetite, fatigue, irritability, or headache.
- Any discharge or drainage from the eyes, nose, ears, or open sores.

Children who show signs or symptoms listed above must be picked up within an hour of parent being contacted. I appreciate your cooperation with this policy.

If you have any questions concerning this policy and whether your child should attend, please call me at (931) 249-3695 before bringing your child to the childcare. For a complete breakdown of this policy please see our webpage preschoolprep.net. You will find a list of illnesses/symptoms with daycare return dates. If you knowingly bring your child to daycare sick or after giving them any medication to assist with an illness. Your childcare spot will be terminated on the spot. Please remember that your child/children are telling us when they receive medicine or if they are sick. This is not acceptable.
